

2008 Summit Christian College Scholarship Procedures

How to Apply:

- Fill out application
 - Scholarships fall into five categories: awarded, merit, academic, status, and need based. Students may not receive more than one scholarship from any one category.
 - Students applying for multiple scholarships need to fill out one application per scholarship.
 - Students applying for need based scholarships need to complete a Phoebe application, which can be obtained from the Admissions Office.
- Gather any additional requirements
- Write essay
 - Students applying for awarded scholarships need to submit a 500-word essay. The essay will include 1) a description of the career you would like to pursue, and the reasons for this choice and 2) the characteristics that you consider most important in a Christian leader.
 - Students applying for merit, academic and status need not submit an essay.
- Return all materials to the Admissions Office
 - All awarded scholarship applications are due May 1, 2008. No late applications will be accepted for awarded scholarships.
 - All merit, academic and status applications are due prior to enrollment.

Awarded Scholarships

Students applying for awarded scholarships must submit the application, essay and any listed requirements.

- Tabitha Scholarship
 - New or returning female students in a Bible major
 - Dispersed as funds are available
- Beaver City Scholarship
 - New or returning male students in a Bible major with a preaching emphasis
 - \$250 for one semester
- David Scholarship
 - New or returning students with an interest in music, preaching, or arts
 - Up to 25% tuition for one semester
 - Must submit a printed text of a sermon preached or audio or video sample of work performed in music, preaching, or the arts
- Meadow Dale Christian Ranch Scholarship
 - New or returning student
 - \$100 for books for one semester
- Dean of Students Scholarship
 - New or returning students based upon Christian character, service, and future plans
 - Up to 25% tuition for one semester

- Must submit a reference to be received with the application from a teacher, counselor, employer, or minister; or be recommended by a member of SCC faculty or staff.

Merit Scholarships

Students applying for merit scholarships must submit the application and any listed requirements.

- Honor Camper Scholarship—\$250 one time scholarship
 - Submit a copy of honor camper scholarship or a verification letter from youth sponsor
- Kiamichi Preacher Boy winners and runners up—100% tuition for first year of post-secondary education
 - Must submit a copy of award or verification letter from minister or youth minister
- NACC Bible Bowl winners and runners up—100% tuition for first year of post-secondary education
 - Must submit a copy of award or verification letter from Bible Bowl sponsor
- Valedictorian—100% tuition for first year of post-secondary education
 - Must submit a high school transcript or verification letter from high school counselor
 - Final transcript must be submitted upon graduation. Loss of class rank will cause loss of scholarship
- Barnabas Scholarship—25% tuition for the Barnabas Award winner

Academic Scholarships

Students applying for academic scholarships must submit the application and any listed requirements.

- President's Scholarship
 - New incoming students based upon high school academic achievement
 - Must submit ACT score and high school transcript
 - Final transcript must be submitted upon graduation. Final GPA will affect scholarship
 - 25% tuition for an ACT score of 23 and an accumulative GPA of 3.0
 - 50% tuition for an ACT score of 25 and an accumulative GPA of 3.5
 - 100% tuition for an ACT score of 27 and an accumulative GPA of 3.75
- Academic Dean's Scholarship
 - Granted in the fall semester to returning students based on academic achievement from the prior academic year
 - 10% tuition for a final GPA of 3.5
 - 20% tuition for a final GPA of 3.75
 - 25% tuition for a final GPA of 4.0

Status Scholarships

Students applying for status scholarships need only submit the application yearly.

- Missionary Dependent—50% tuition
- Minister Dependent—50% tuition

- Spouse of full-time SCC student—25% tuition
- Dependent of SCC full time staff or faculty—100% tuition
- Senior (55 years old or older)—Up to 100% tuition based upon ministry goals

Need Based Scholarships

Anyone interested in applying for a need based scholarship needs to complete a Phoebe application which can be obtained from the Admissions Office.

All scholarships are for tuition only; students who receive scholarships are still responsible for dorm rent and all fees. Scholarships are available to full time students who have fulfilled Mentored Ministry and chapel requirements, and are not on academic or character probation.

When a student receives multiple scholarships, the first scholarship will apply to the normal tuition rate. Each additional scholarship will be calculated on and applied to the remaining cost of tuition after the previous scholarship has been applied.
